

The *School District Policing Study, May 2003* is a research project that was initiated at the request of the Board of Trustees. It addresses EPISD police services, El Paso municipal police services, and practices of school district police across Texas. Financial and enrollment information from the Public Education Information System (PEIMS) is presented, comparing ten Texas districts.

The initial purpose of the study was to determine the feasibility of outsourcing police and security services to the City of El Paso and to investigate the district policing of several large districts in Texas. The study presents a wealth of quantitative and qualitative information,
