

## 1-AAAA/2AAAA POST-SEASON COMPETITION

The District Executive Committee of Districts 1-AAAA and 2-AAAA agree to the following playoff format beginning with the 2008-2009 season.

The premise of this agreement is that the higher district ranking team of each district will host the lower district ranking team of the opposing district. The host teams will have the option to choose the day and time of the game.

### **Football**

At the end of the regular season, the top four teams of each district advance to the playoffs. Each district must determine 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> place finalists before teams are placed into their respective UIL divisions.

The two teams from each district with the largest enrollment will go into UIL Division I. The two teams with the lowest enrollment will go into UIL Division II.

Of the two schools from each district in each division, the highest district ranking team of each district will host the lower district ranking team of the opposing district. If the two teams from each district have the same district ranking, then a coin toss will determine the host team. (The exception would be if the two teams have the same district ranking and played each other in Bi-District the prior year, then the opposite team would host the current year.)

### **Volleyball**

For the Bi-district games, the #1 team in each district will host the #4 team of the opposing district. The # 2 team in each district will host the #3 team of the opposing district.

### **Basketball**

For the Bi-district games, the #1 team in each district will host the #4 team of the opposing district. The # 2 team in each district will host the #3 team of the opposing district.

### **Baseball/Softball**


For the Bi-district games, the #1 team in each district will host the #4 team of the opposing district. The # 2 team in each district will host the #3 team of the opposing district. Bi-district games can be a one-game format or a series format. This will be determined by following UIL guidelines. If the Bi-district is to be a best 2 of 3 series, the higher seeded team from each district may choose to host the Friday game or host the one/two Saturday games. The lower seeded team of each district would host the games not chosen by the higher seeded teams.

### **Soccer**

For the Bi-district games, the #1 team in each district will host the #4 team of the opposing district. The # 2 team in each district will host the #3 team of the opposing district.
