

Middle Schools

The principal of the home school may charge admission to games provided:

- the maximum charge does not exceed \$2.00, unless approved by the Athletic Office.
- the principal charging must inform the other school, and both student bodies must be notified.

The Athletic Office will charge admission to all district and city championship games hosted by EPISD. Adults will be charged \$3.00 and students and employees will be charged \$2.00

Athletic Events Passes

The principal of each high school will receive 100 employee passes to be distributed to coaches, administrators, and their spouses. The middle school administrator and coaches will receive passes from the Athletic Office.

Individual Game Passes

High school principals may issue complementary UIL passes and game passes to EPISD athletic events.

The junior varsity teams and freshman teams will be admitted at the pass gate when they identify themselves and their names appear on the pass list.

Band members will be admitted, if in uniform.

Band boosters will be admitted with a district pass.

Majorettes, twirlers, drill teams and cheerleaders, in uniform, will be admitted if their school is playing.

Employee Passes

Each employee of the El Paso Independent School District may purchase two passes for \$20.00 per pass. These passes will be honored at all athletic events that are played in an El Paso Independent School District facility with the exception of post-district play. Spectators using employee athletic passes must sign in at the gate. These passes will not be honored at facilities in other school districts. The holders of employee passes may be required to show some form of identification, such as a driver's license, upon request by a game employee. Any abuse of the privileges of these passes will result in the pass being revoked. Lost passes will be replaced at a \$5.00 fee with the Athletic Director's approval.
