### **STAAR End of Course (EOC) Intervention**

TEC §39.025(b-1) requires school districts to provide accelerated instruction to each student who fails to perform satisfactorily on a STAAR EOC assessment. Students who did not meet passing standards on English I, English II, US History, Biology, or Algebra I STAAR EOC assessments are invited to attend EOC Intervention classes at their high school campus.

### **Credit Recovery**

### **Original Credit**

Courses for original credit during the summer to assist students in getting ahead have limited offerings and may be tuition based if offered. There is no cost for students needing these courses to successfully complete magnet or CTE student programs. Please contact your child's high school for course options and registration info.

### **Original Credit ELL Summer English**

English courses for ELL students needing to take original credit in order to stay on cohort and graduate on time are offered at varying high schools depending on enrollment. There is no charge for these courses to qualifying ELL students. Locations TBA based on enrollment needs.
