The Transmountain Early College High School is an educational opportunity provided through the collaboration of the El Paso Independent School District, the El Paso Community College, Educate Texas and the Texas Education Agency. This unique school is specifically designed to provide students with a rigorous course of study focused on a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) model, complemented with a wide range of Fine Arts offerings. Students attending the school will be provided advanced coursework that enables the student to attain an Associate Degree while completing his/her high school diploma. The school redefines the typical comprehensive high school experience into an academically oriented small school setting housed on the Transmountain campus of the El Paso Community College.

Part II: Applicant Criteria, Important Information and Selection Process

The criteria for selecting and retaining students into the Transmountain Early College High School are as follows:

- The applicant must meet ALL requirements for promotion from eighth grade to ninth grade
 - The applicant must attend a two-week Summer Bridge Program in June of 2021.
 - The applicant must have completed the online application, or submitted the application for admission to his/her middle school counselor or TMECHS administration by the deadline of November 20, 2020. (Applications received after the deadline will be accepted but will be placed on a waiting list).
 - Incoming students must meet “College Level” on the Reading and Writing TSIA2 (college readiness test) by July 1, 2021 to be enrolled in dual credit courses in their freshmen year. There will be many opportunities for incoming freshmen to pass this test in Summer Bridge 2021 and during the 2021-2022 school year.
 - If the student does not qualify for college classes prior to the start of the 9th grade year but meets the standard during the 9th grade year, he/she may be required to attend summer classes prior to the 10th grade year to make up the college courses missed.

- While attending Transmountain Early College High School, if the student experiences issues with attendance, tardiness, discipline, low grades due to lack of effort, or lack of parent/guardian cooperation, the administration reserves the right to recommend that the student’s transfer to Transmountain Early College High School be revoked and the student returned to his/her home campus.
 - The applicant and guardian must be aware that the Transmountain Early College High School does not have lockers; therefore, the applicant is required to carry his/her books/supplies, etc.
 - UIL Competitive sports and Marching Band, are not offered on the Transmountain Early College High School campus, although many Fine Arts programs and athletic opportunities are available.
 - Roundtrip transportation is only provided from the applicant’s EPISD home high school campus. The applicant is responsible for getting to/from his/her home school.

The process for selecting students for admission into the Transmountain Early College High School is as follows:

- A lottery process will be used to select the students for admission if more than 125 qualified students apply.
- A total of 125 students will be admitted.
