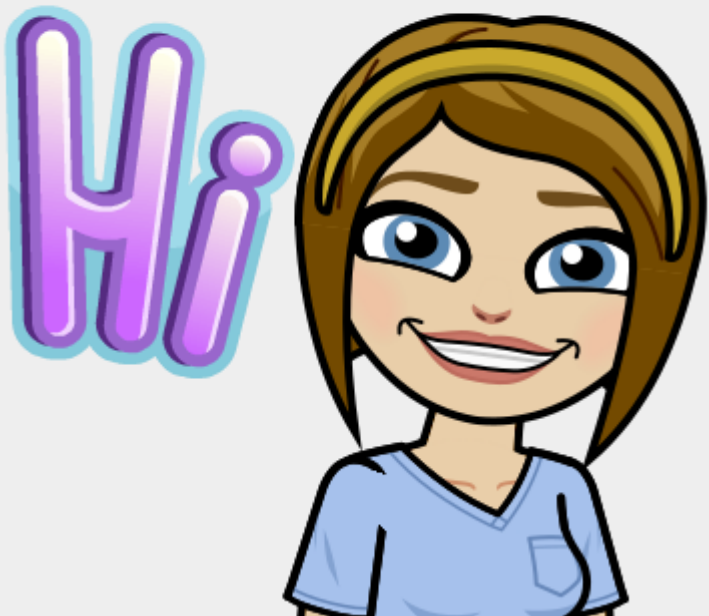

COVID-19 SURVEY



PLEASE evaluate your student(s) with the following questions:

1. Has your child had a fever or taken fever reducing medication?
 2. Has your child experienced any shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, loss of taste and smell, sore throat, cough, aches/pains, or diarrhea?
- If your child answered yes, please keep your child quarantined at home for 14 days.
 - If your child answered no, they must agree to the next statement:

Your child agrees to practice social distancing regulations (6ft apart from others) and wear their self-provided PPE (mask) at all times on campus.

Important Tips on COVID-19



Remember if your student is directly exposed to anyone that has tested positive for COVID-19, THEY ARE NOT ALLOWED TO ATTEND SCHOOL until they have been quarantined for 14 days. You may take your student to their medical doctor or a COVID-19 testing site. If your student has a confirmed COVID-19 result, please keep your student at home until:

- 14 days have passed since symptoms began.
- 24 hours fever-free (WITHOUT medication).
- Medical doctor release.

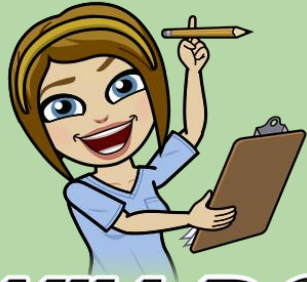
Don't Forget!

Does your student need medication(s) at school? Here is the process:



WILL DO 

- Parents please use the forms in this file that fit your student's medical needs and conditions. **ALL** medications or procedures that your student needs to receive on campus during school hours needs a doctor's order in our EPISD form.
- If your student does not have asthma, diabetes or a severe food allergy please use the general medication permission form for the doctor to complete.
- Medication will not be accepted by the School Nurse without the doctors order. Over the counter medication needs to be sealed, the School Nurse will not accept open medication.

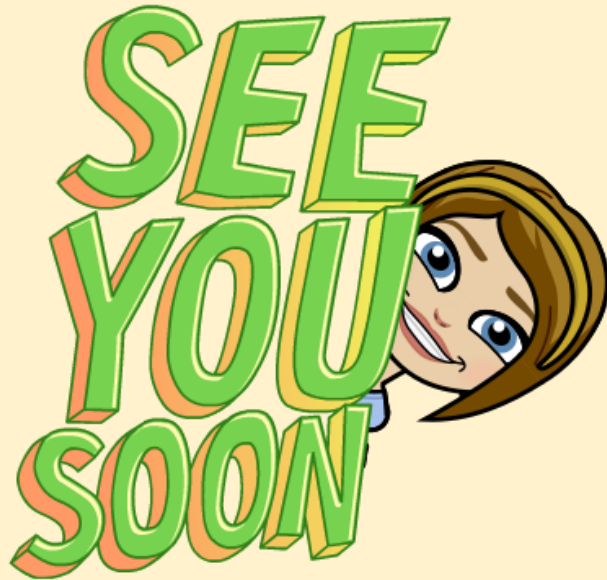
*Medications **MUST** be brought into the School Nurse's office by the parent.*
