



SCHOOL WIDE UNIFORM POLICY

The school uniform policy will be enforced to include after school activities.

Uniforms may also be purchased from local discount stores and uniform apparel stores. In either case, Youth and Adult sizes are available.

Jaguar Uniform Fast Facts

If an item of clothing or accessory is not addressed, it is not allowed.

*ID badges are considered part of the school uniform and must be in the students possession at all times.

*Hats, scarves, and gloves/mittens are permitted on cold weather days and may not be worn in the building.

*Black or brown leather style belt (simple traditional buckle) must be worn. No logo,

insignia, etc. may be on the buckle. Shirts must be tucked in.

*All uniform items (shoes, tops, bottoms) must be worn appropriately.

BOTTOMS

- Color: khaki, navy
- Variety of bottoms: pants, capris, shorts/skorts/skirts (at least to the knee)
- Style: No cargo pants, no skinny pants
- Material: Cotton Twill (no denim, no spandex or like materials)
- Sizing: no oversized, tight fitting, baggy, sagging, or low rise
- Condition: no frayed, torn

TOPS

- Tops: short and long sleeved polo shirts only. Tops must be cotton material and have school logo.
- Undershirts: short or long sleeved.
- Approved colors for tops and undershirts: navy blue, hunter green, or white. School Spirit Shirts may be worn on Fridays only. School team uniform tops may be worn on Fridays or on game day with school shirt underneath, tucked in,

SWEATERS/JACKETS/SWEATSHIRTS

- Only solid-colored navy blue or hunter green sweaters, jackets, or sweatshirts permitted. The school logo is the only logo allowed.

The following items are unacceptable:

- Caps, hats, bandanas, scarves, knit caps, beanies or similar items
- Oversized jewelry. Earrings cannot be larger than a quarter or longer than an



inch (1") in length. **Only one earring per earlobe.**

- Make-up and/or accessories that are distracting or interfere with instruction.
- Facial piercings of any kind or body decorations to include stickers, decals, drawings, graffiti writing or paintings
- Flip-flop style shoes, clogs, boots, or sandals.
- Backless, open-toed, platform, slipper-style, or spike-heeled shoes. Shoes must be same style, same color (matching pair). Shoes must have matching laces properly tied; all other shoes must be properly fastened. Socks must be a solid hunter green, navy blue, white or black. Brand logos allowed.
- Unnatural hair color. Hair may not cover the eyes.
- Mohawks and designs cut/shaved into hair.
- Sunglasses are not to be worn in the building, including on top of student's head except prescription transition lenses.
- Any items deemed inappropriate by Administration.

Violation of Uniform Policy

- 1st Violation – Warning/Call Home
- 2nd Violation–Detention
- 3rd Violation – Detention
- 4th Violation – Referral to Administration

Excessive Violations to the Uniform Policy can result in:

- ISS (In School Suspension) or OSS (Out of School Suspension)

- Recommendation to Alternative Program

NOTE: It is the student/parent's responsibility to know the policy and adhere to it. As students outgrow uniforms, uniforms must be replaced.

The Nolan Richardson Administration will have the final authority in determining whether or not a student's attire meets the campus uniform policy.

Any items deemed inappropriate will be addressed by Administration on an individual basis. Students who do not adhere to the above guidelines will be required to change into school-issued uniform.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION ATTIRE

The PE uniform is to be worn during PE only.

TOPS

- Color: navy blue, hunter green, gray or white
- Variety of tops: t-shirt
- Material: cotton
- Sizing: no oversized or tight fitting

BOTTOMS

- Color: navy blue, hunter green, gray
- Variety of bottoms: Shorts (must be to the knee) or sweatpants
- Material: cotton
- Sizing: no oversized, extra short, or tight fitting



FINE ARTS ATTIRE

On scheduled Fine/Arts days where students need to arrive in Band/Orchestra/Choir attire, the attire is as follows:

TOPS

- Color: Authorized Fine Arts Dress shirt/polo
- Material: Cotton
- Sizing: No oversized or tight fitting

BOTTOMS

- Color: Black
- Variety of bottoms: Slacks Only No **Jeans**
- Material: Cotton
- Sizing: no oversized, extra short, or tight fitting
- Black shoes/socks
- No skinny fitting pants

“FREE DRESS” GUIDELINES

On designated “Free Dress Days,” students are expected to dress appropriately for school and follow the “Free Dress” guidelines that will be distributed before Free Dress Days.

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Lockers:

Students may only use assigned lockers. No sharing of lockers. Students must have lock on assigned locker. Students may access lockers before school, during transitions, and after school.





Nolan Richardson Middle School Backpack Policy

Beginning 2018-2019 School Year



Clear backpacks, string bags, and purses (no larger than 8"x9") are permitted. Students may carry only ONE clear backpack or string bag. All other backpacks, duffle bags, tote bags, and any other bags deemed inappropriate by administration are not permitted. Unauthorized backpacks or bags will be confiscated if brought on campus. Student-athletes may leave bags for major sports in their major sports lockers each morning if a coach is available to unlock the locker room. Coaches will notify athletes of locker room availability at the beginning of each season. Bags for major sports will be confiscated if brought into buildings other than the Gym.
