#### WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT CONSTRUCTION THIS SUMMER

EPISD is modernizing its campuses and that means construction crews are hard at work. We want to provide our parents with some construction safety information regarding Bond 2016 projects.

Construction will occur on different areas of the campuses according to a phasing plan created by the general contractor and approved by school administration. # **IRVIN** GROUNDBREAKING

EPISD broke ground on the \$51-million dollar Bond 2016 project at Irvin High School on March 11. The groundbreaking ceremony marked the start of construction and included students, teachers, trustees and alumni who were excited to see a change on their campus. "This is a very important day in the history of Irvin High School," Principal MaryAnna Giba said. "Today marks the beginning of a project that will help us better meet the educational goals of our students."

The project at Irvin includes the construction of a new building to house administrative offices and special education, a new 300-seat theater, gut rehabilitation of all classrooms and security improvements. The general contractor for the project is HB Construction and they are pushing to have the project complete by December of 2021.

Irvin will also be receiving new turf, new lighting for softball and baseball and a new track as part of the 2016 Bond Athletic improvements.







## **BOBBY JOE HILL** GROUNDBREAKING

EPISD broke ground on Bobby Joe Hill PK8, the consolidation of Terrace Hills Middle and Collins Elementary, during a groundbreaking ceremony on April 5. The ceremony included EPISD officials, school staff, students and members of the Bobby Joe Hill family all excited to get the project started.

The \$35.4-million dollar project includes the construction of new elementary classrooms, new administrative offices, new fine arts classrooms and major renovations to Terrace Hills classrooms. The project also includes an expansion of the Terrace Hills library and the demolition of the middle school eighth grade center and Collins elementary.

The campus is named after Bobby Joe Hill, a trailblazer basketball player who led the 1966 Texas Western Miners to an NCAA championship breaking racial barriers in collegiate sports along the way. Hill was one of the first African-American starters that was part of the legendary UTEP Coach Don Haskins team to win the title.

Board President Bob Geske recalled his days playing alongside Bobby Joe Hill, "He was one of the finest people I ever met in my life. He did so much for the community."

Bobby Joe Hill PK8 is set to open in the fall of 2021. All construction will be completed by the 2022 spring semester.
