

Andress High School Dress Code

2022-2023



- Shorts, skirts and/or dresses must be longer than the students' hand knuckles when standing.
- Footwear must be worn at all times. Enclosed shoes are preferred for the personal safety of the student.
- No slippers, house shoes or pajamas are allowed.
- Students may not wear dark glasses while inside the school building.
- Pants and shorts must be worn at or above the waist and must stay above the waist without a belt. All oversized clothing to include "bagging" or "sagging" is not permitted.
- Over-sized belt with one end hanging down is prohibited as well as belt buckles with initials.
- Any clothing, jewelry, or tattoos that advertise or promote illegal drugs, alcohol, tobacco products, violence, gang affiliation or racist ideas may not be worn.
- Bandanas of any color may not be worn or visible at any time.
- Low cut blouses, undershirts, fish net, muscle shirts, tube tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, racerback tops, or tops with revealing necklines in the front or back are not to be worn even if covered by an over blouse, jacket, cardigan, or sweater.
- Tops with excessive armholes are not allowed even with a shirt underneath.
- Male students must wear shirts at all times during all school sponsored activities.

Students who violate the school dress code will be asked to wear an alternative clothing to replace inappropriate clothing or the school will contact parents to bring appropriate clothing.

Repeated offenses could result in ISS, OSS or Alternative Placement.

The administration reserves the right to extend the dress code to include attire not listed specifically above, but which is deemed to be inappropriate. It is imperative and vital to maintain an environment which provides for the safety and academic success of all our students.
