Helpful Tips

- Distribute and/or post the Parent Notification Letter prior to survey administration
 - parents are instructed to contact the school if child is NOT participating
- Principals will receive an email from this department (ASAP) on 9/30/19 with the survey link
 - share the link with the campus staff responsible for administering the survey
 - do not share the survey link with another campus, it is specific to each individual school
- Campus staff should keep a list of students absent during the survey administration
 - this will aid the campus in identifying any pending survey completions
 - student participation is anonymous and cannot be tracked other than what the campus puts into place
- Responses will not be recorded unless the student clicks submit at the end of the survey
 - campus staff should verify students click submit OR staff click submit for the student
- Students submit only one survey
 - survey students during a specific class or period to prevent multiple submissions
- Elementary campuses only survey 5th graders
