  3. Know which courses are offered! Course Request Sheet

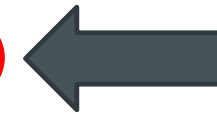

# FRESHMEN – ESSENTIALS

- **Knock out Graduation Requirements first!**
- Know if you are Magnet

# SOPHOMORE - ESSENTIALS

- Check your Endorsement – make sure it is still what you want to do.
  - Notify Counselor if need to change (**Last Opportunity to Change**)
- Are you interested in CCTE? Check website for programs BEFORE meeting with counselor.

- Know if you are Magnet
  - PTECH, STEM, Dual Language, AP Capstone
- Advanced Courses
  - Dual Credit opportunities in Pre Cal, US History. OnRamps, AP, etc. (TSI)
- Possibility to Double Block Sports

# JUNIOR - ESSENTIALS

- Check your Endorsement – make sure you are on track.
  - Notify Counselor if need to change (Should not be changing endorsement at this stage)
- If you are in CCTE, you must continue program! <https://www.episd.org/ccte>
- Know if you are Magnet
  - PTECH, STEM, Dual Language, AP Capstone
- Advanced Courses
  - Dual Credit opportunities in Pre Cal, OnRamps, AP, etc. (TSI)
- CCR
  - If you have not met CCR, you will be placed in English and Math College Prep
- Pre-Requisites
  - Some courses require you to complete other courses. Example: Food Science
- Double Block Sports
- If you have completed your fine arts credit, no new arts allowed.

# JUNIOR ESSENTIALS CONTINUED

- OUTS
  - Students must provide proof of employment or proof of an internship to qualify for an OUT period.
  - Out periods are only given to Seniors.
  - Out periods can ONLY be 1st, 4th, 5th, and 8th period.
- Courtesy
  - Must receive approval from counselor. If you are assigned a teacher, you will serve as a tutor in those classes.
  - Must have good behavior, attendance, and academic record.
