2019-2020 Registration Information

Pre- Registration for incoming freshman will be on December 13th at Morehead Middle School and December 14th at Lincoln Middle School. Counselors from Coronado High school will be at each school to assist students in making their course selections for the 2019-2020 school year.

Students attending Coronado HS in the 2019-2020 school year will take 8 classes. Classes are scheduled on an A/B block where periods 1-4 will meet on A day and periods 5-8 will meet on B day. All students will take 1 class in English, Math, Science and Social Studies. Students have a choice of taking regular or Pre-AP/AP classes for these core subjects. Pre-AP and AP courses are advanced courses that require more time for reading and assignments outside of class. Grades are weighted for these courses. Students may select as many of these classes as they want, but keep in mind the increased workload needs to be balanced with other activities the students will be involved in (Major Sports, Band/Orchestra etc.)

The remaining classes will be based on the House Bill 5 Graduation requirements **AND** the student's Endorsement/Program of Study selection. All students must select a Program of study from the following 5 categories:

Arts and Humanities

Multi-Disciplinary

Public Service

Business and Industry

STEM

Middle school counselors have been working with the students to assist them in making their Endorsement selections. **Parents, Students and the Counselor must all sign off on the selection choice.** This form will determine what additional courses will be needed for graduation. A House Bill 5 Endorsement form for Coronado High School has been attached to the pre-registration information so that you can fill this out and submit this when your child pre-registers for their classes. **As per State Law, this form must be kept on file** so that both students and counselors can reference this when making class selections all 4 years in high school.

Students will be encouraged to take a foreign language if they haven't already completed this requirement in middle school as all students need 2 years of a foreign language to graduate.

Students will also need to complete 1 year of PE for graduation. Next year they can choose to take a Major Sport, ROTC, or PE to complete this requirement. Marching band can also substitute for PE.

In addition, all students need 1 year of a fine arts course and 1 year of a technology course for graduation. We encourage the students to take these courses as freshman. This will give them more choices of electives when they are juniors and seniors.

The last class selection will be based on the student's endorsement choice. Students may decide to take 2 fine arts courses or Major Sports AND ROTC to account for their 8th class selection. High School Counselors will assist students to determine the possibility of taking more than 1 class in a subject area.
