
1. Please make sure that you have registered for <https://lead4ward.com/>.

It is crucial that students take the tests. If students are in your classes, please advise them of the importance of the test.
7. **This may be subject to change: Teachers, not on ADA, will report to campus on Friday, November 6th. Please plan Asynchronous lessons for Friday. Schools will have to open buildings to identified priority populations (not to exceed 25% of the students whose parents chose F2F instruction). These will be students who are failing 2 or more core classes or not showing up for online instruction.
