



## **Zavala Elementary Campus Parent Engagement Policy 2021-2022**

**Goal:** Zavala Elementary administration, faculty and staff will collaborate with parents to develop a plan that ensures active participation of parents in the education of their children.

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**Objective 8:** To provide teachers training on parental involvement, specifically, on the importance of the home school connection and how to communicate and collaborate with parents as equal partners in the education of their children and to capacitate on how parents can provide feedback to teachers, administration, counselor, and the school.

**Objective 9:** To provide reasonable support for parental involvement activities requested by the parents (Engagement Plan. Parent Survey).
